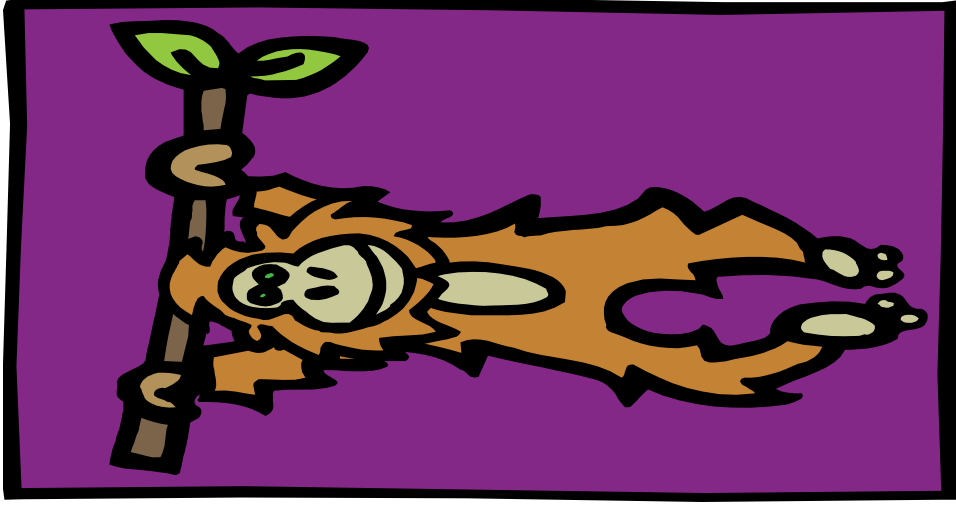

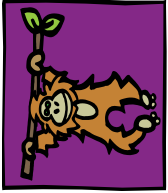

MONKEY BUSINESS

MONKEY BUSINESS is a benefit and consignment shop located at 8624 B Germantown Avenue, Philadelphia, PA. The shop first opened on April 19, 1955. More than 35 volunteers operate the shop. All profits benefit the Green Tree Community Health Foundation.

VOLUNTEERS OF MONKEY BUSINESS over the past 50 plus years of service, commitment, labor and love have made Monkey Business a success. We are always looking for additional volunteers. Anyone interested in volunteering should contact us.

MERCHANDISE FOR SALE at Monkey Business consists of all types of new and used upscale clothing, shoes and accessories. Articles for sale are acquired from regular consignment, special consignment, and donations (for tax credit).

MONKEY BUSINESS CONSIGNORS pay a small fee. The fee covers one full consignment season, from January to December. Volunteers price all the merchandise accepted for sale through consignment. On any item sold, one-half of the sale price goes to the consignor, and one-half to the **Green Tree Community Health Foundation**.

MONKEY BUSINESS CONSIGNMENT operates by appointment only. Twenty (20) items may be consigned at any one time. All clothing must be cleaned, pressed, placed on hangers and be up-to-date. Any article that remains unsold and unclaimed after four weeks in the shop will become the property of Monkey Business.

QUALITY OF MERCHANDISE — Monkey Business requires that clothing be seasonal, in current style, freshly laundered or cleaned and free from stains and damage. All merchandise must be clean and in salable condition.

DONATIONS OF MERCHANDISE are most welcome at Monkey Business. Clothing will only be accepted if on hangers and cleaned, ready for display. We accept salable items as either outright donations or donations for tax receipts. These items are priced by volunteers and added to the items on sale at Monkey Business. To receive tax credit, donations must be received by a volunteer, who in turn gives a receipt to the donor for the clothing. All items should be clean AND in salable condition.

GIFTS may be made to Monkey Business using the form supplied in this pamphlet.

LOCATION—Monkey Business is located in the historic shopping district of Chestnut Hill off the cobblestone streets in the Rex Avenue parking lot #9. Free parking is available directly outside of the shop.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION is provided by buses and regional rail lines. Monkey Business is conveniently located near the Chestnut Hill East and West rail lines.
